# The Discipleship Journey

## KMN ASST. SUPT. / CHURCH PLANTING

A simple definition of discipleship is 'moving people forward in faith.' In most churches, Christ's Chapel included, that process is haphazard at best with little intentionality. That's not to say discipleship doesn't happen in our churches. It's just an acknowledgement that examples of a systematic plan in place that measures spiritual growth in our churches are few and far between. In the complex world of pastoring, other staffing and ministry demands often take priority. After 35 years of pastoring in one location, I've just recently hired our first staff person with 'discipleship' as their specific job description! I'm hopeful our church becomes better at this process as a result.

It seems a church must have two components in place for making disciples: a means of measuring spiritual growth and a plan in place to accomplish the goal. Over the years I've used 'The Acts 2 Journey', Rick Warren's 'Purpose Driven Church', and 'The ABC's of Natural Church Development' to help put in



place a loosely organized structure that promotes spiritual growth. I recommend each one as a step in the right direction if a discipleship journey has been difficult to organize in your place of ministry.

I would also recommend contacting Dr. Gary Brackett. Pastor Joe Girdler, our Superintendent, has invited Dr. Brackett to assist in helping smaller churches in Kentucky put into place a discipleship process that is doable for most of us. Dr. Brackett spoke at our virtual Sectional Council in 2020 and has tremendous resources available for our use within the context of our own congregation and community.

God rescued James from the enemy’s grasp and radically transformed his life. That transformation led him to involvement in short term mission trips to Mexico, Uganda, Guatemala, Jamaica, South Africa, Botswana, Romania, and England. During these years, his burden for the United Kingdom continued to grow and then, God opened the door to serve as an MA with Missionaries Rick & Gloria McCartney in Wales.

Wales is a secularized country of the United Kingdom where God is considered to be irrelevant, if He is even considered at all. Churches that once flourished have been shut down and turned into motels, offices or apartments. Close to 60% of the country are atheists or have declared "no religion". Of the small percentage that do go to church the average age is 65 years old. Most people in church are no younger than 50 years old. The majority of the youth in Wales are simply not interested. James will be serving with the McCartneys in outreach to the university campus, church planting and church revitalization. Wales is a wide open and needy mission field!

## Students "Come Together" CHI ALPHA MINISTRIES

Students from four different universities gathered in the midst of a pandemic wearing masks and social distancing to encounter the presence of the Father. There were three main sessions with seven different breakout sessions that basically challenged students to give their lives for the Cause of Christ. There was a prophetic word that said just as the lives of so many youth have been impacted to advance the cause of the kingdom at Camp Crestwood, so will the lives of university students in the future impact the University, the Marketplace and the World for Christ.

And then challenged students to go to the Mission Field or give 1/2 of their annual income to advance the Kingdom of God – that would be a similar sacrifice.

Zack Jones challenged us by asking, "When the Son of Man comes, Will he find faith on the earth? What does Faithfulness look like?" He challenged us to "be about the Father's business

Saturday night, students pounded each other with dodge balls until late in the night (or morning). Then on Sunday morning for more than an hour students shared testimonies of how God had summoned them to live a life worthy of the calling they had received, determined to take the gospel back to the secular universities of Kentucky: UK, Morehead, ECU & WKU. - God’s cleansing—*“If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness”* (1 John 1:9)
- God’s goodness—*“No good thing will He withhold from them that walk uprightly”* (Psalm 84:11)
- God’s faithfulness—*“The Lord will not forsake His people for His great name’s sake”* (1 Samuel 12:22)
- God’s guidance—*“The meek will He guide”* (Psalm 25:9)
- God’s wise plan—*“All things work together for good to them that love God”* (Romans 8:28)

As you are planning Christian Education and Discipleship opportunities at your church, don’t feel overwhelmed. He has already called you to create them and He will provide; curriculum,


